

FMC's Conflict Minerals Statement

FMC Corporation and its subsidiaries ("FMC") are committed to sourcing components and materials from companies that share our values regarding respect for human rights, integrity and environmental responsibility. FMC is committed with complying to Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, which aims to prevent the use of minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or in adjoining countries ("conflict minerals").

Suppliers to FMC are required to commit to being or becoming "conflict-free" (which means that such supplier does not source conflict minerals) and sources only from conflict-free smelters. Supplier's to FMC that are providing 3TG's are required to provide completed EICC-GeSI declarations evidencing such supplier's commitment to becoming conflict-free and documenting countries of origin for the tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold that it purchases.
